Coach Safety Training & Concussion Management

- ▶ All Coaches are trained in Concussion Awareness, Heat Illness Prevention, CPR/AED Operation & Basic First Aide
- ▶ Concussion Management
 - ▶ All players will receive concussion awareness training prior to participating
 - ▶ If we suspect a concussion has occurred, a player will not be allowed to participate until cleared by a medical doctor - **STATE LAW**
 - ▶ **THEN** must go through our “return to play” protocol with our Athletic Trainer

Insurance

- ▶ USD 260 DOES NOT carry primary insurance for student-athletes
- ▶ Limited *Catastrophic* Insurance through KSHSAA is available if there is a need (\$25,000 deductible). If a situation comes up, the Activities Office will contact parents and file necessary paperwork.

Student Eligibility Info

- ▶ Participation in extra-curricular athletics/activities at Derby High School is a **privilege**
- ▶ ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS
 - ▶ A student shall be in school the entire day of practice, performance, contest, program, or trip if he/she expects to participate.
 - ▶ Exceptions may be made if a student is involved in another school-related activity or has written verification of a doctor's appointment. Such verification must be presented to the Athletic and Attendance Offices upon return to school.
 - ▶ Any other exception must be cleared through the Athletic Director/Administration in advance of the absence.
- ▶ STUDENT TRANSPORTATION
 - ▶ Students are expected to ride school transportation to and from away events
 - ▶ If there is a need for a student to ride with a ***parent or legal guardian*** to

Student Eligibility Info

▶ GRADE REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Student must be enrolled in eight and have passed six new subjects of unit weight the previous semester in order to be eligible for the current semester.
 - ▶ **Zero Hour/Lab Aide/Teacher's Assistant does not count. Homeroom is not a full subject of unit weight.**
- ▶ If a student passes five classes (KSHSAA requirement) the previous semester, they may go on a weekly Grade Card check to maintain eligibility in the current semester.
- ▶ There are exceptions for students taking college classes off campus, as well as approved Work Based Learning.
 - ▶ 3 College Credits = 1 High School Class
 - ▶ 5 College Credits = 2 High School Classes

NCAA Eligibility Center

- ▶ To be eligible at a NCAA Division I or II school, student-athletes must meet minimum requirements.
 - ▶ STRONGLY encouraged by student's Sophomore year
- ▶ NCAA allows you to set up a Profile Page for free as early as your Freshmen year.

 - ▶ This can be turned into a NCAA Registered account once you are being recruited

▶ Required Core GPA: DI 2.3 and DII 2.2

NAIA Eligibility Center

- ▶ To be eligible at a NAIA School, requirements may differ from school to school
 - ▶ NAIA Clearinghouse

Do not allow your student-athlete to wait until their Senior year. If there is a chance they want to play in college, get them registered early and monitor grades/classes *every* semester.

Role of the Parent towards student

1. TEAM SPECIFIC COACH (Position/Level Coach)
2. HEAD COACH

Things to discuss: ATHLETIC DIRECTOR

1. **Ways to improve your child**
2. **Concerns about your child's behavior**
3. **Students mental or physical treatment**

Things not to discuss:

1. **Team Strategy**
2. **Play Calling or Philosophy**
3. **Other Student Athletes**
